

# PRESIDENT'S REPORT ON BEHALF OF THE EUMUNDI CHAMBER OF COMMERCE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE

## **AGM Meeting 1 Oct 2020**

Greetings and a warm welcome to our members.

I am pleased to present my President's report to the 2020 AGM covering our achievements over the past year.

I'm proud to make this declaration on behalf of an incredible management committee, whom, without their dedication none of our achievements could have been made possible.

Some of our key achievements include:

## **Membership Growth & Networking**

Continuing on from last year, we have seen a steady increase in new memberships from a diverse range of industry types over the last year.

This is a great achievement for chamber, especially in the face of numerous obstacles stemming from the COVID pandemic, as we have been able to represent a broader section of the business community when communicating to our regional partners and stakeholders.

From March of this year, our chamber breakfast functions transformed into a series of online Zoom meetings with a slew of economic updates from local, state and federal agencies. We soon realised that the two track effects on local businesses were evident in that some saw little change while others, especially hospitality businesses were in a fight for survival in the face of unprecedented regulations brought about by the virus.

We thank all of you for your attendance and we hope we helped deliver pertinent information to keep you abreast of the avalanche of changes we encountered throughout the year. We'll continue to keep you up to date as we move towards the end of a tumultuous year.

## **Recognition of Chamber**

As a result of networking efforts of the management committee, Chamber has been able to build closer relationships with Sunshine Coast Council, State and Federal government as well as Visit Sunshine Coast and Noosa Tourism and especially the CCIQ.

We have also participated in the Eumundi Business Awards hosted by Eumundi Square with record nominations received as well as increased participation of member businesses resulting in joint winners for the Eumundi Business of the year.

As a consequence Eumundi Chamber is recognised as a key community group to connect local businesses with stakeholders as we all the wider business community.

We have also been engaging more with other regional chambers for the purposes of understanding common issues that are faced by others in the wider region, learning how to do things better.

We will be focusing on opportunities to build on these relationships more over the coming year.

# **Eumundi Identity & PlaceMaking Participation**

In March 2018, Visit Sunshine Coast (VSC) expressed the desire to establish clear identities that could position + differentiate the sub-regions within the wider Sunshine Coast proposition.

Conscious of being defined by the stalwarts of Noosa + Mooloolaba, VSC's objective is to widen the appeal of the Sunshine Coast as a whole + provide more reasons for people to come back.

As competition for visitor numbers, OVE's + destination awareness increases, regions are digging deep to distinguish themselves from their competitors, both domestic + overseas. By recognising + defining what makes each sub-region special, we are able to take the traditional tourism demographic approach + align customer types with sub-region identities.

This report outlined the strategic process + outcomes for the development of the Subregion Identity for Eumundi, set within the context of the Sunshine Coast destination.

The workshop and report was just the beginning. Now, in 2020, we are now entering the beginning of anticipated change to our community in collaboration with Council on the Placemaking Program to bring many of the insights generated in the Identity study into realty. The framework developed will allow the Eumundi Operators/Experience Eumundi and Sunshine Coast Council to carve out a clearer path in our built environment now and into the future. Pre planning work has already commenced and the rubber hits the road starting in November of this year to get community feedback and communications with Council underway on this exciting journey.

## **ECCO Ltd**

In my third year as a chamber representative director of ECCO Ltd, its been all hands on deck dealing with fallout from the lockdowns, Job Keeper issues, and how to address a bombshell effect of an immediate and continued loss of revenue from market closures. We doubled our efforts throughout most of this year focusing on administrative/financial issues, the reluctant demise of The Green publication as well as operating all other business units of ECCO in the face of mounting challenges.

I would like to thank my fellow chamber representative director Cindy Suters for her hard work on the ECCO board when we saw Craig Manly step down from that role earlier in the year.

#### **Chamber Direction**

Coming off of a year where we focused on investing in Chamber's internal communications, new website and logo and Lonergan Lane. We never dreamed how invaluable a communication tool such as the new website could be until tested under recent events.

We came to rely heavily on our new communication tool to expeditiously disseminate valuable information from various government organisations to our members as quickly and efficiently as possible.

We continue working with the Chamber Alliance and other stakeholders to gain insight as to what services might be of the most value to our members.

We have also continued working closely with ECCO's Experience Eumundi team to create opportunities for chamber members and to ensure matters such as our website and the promotion of member services is done as efficiently as possible and in a way that delivers the best value to our members.
